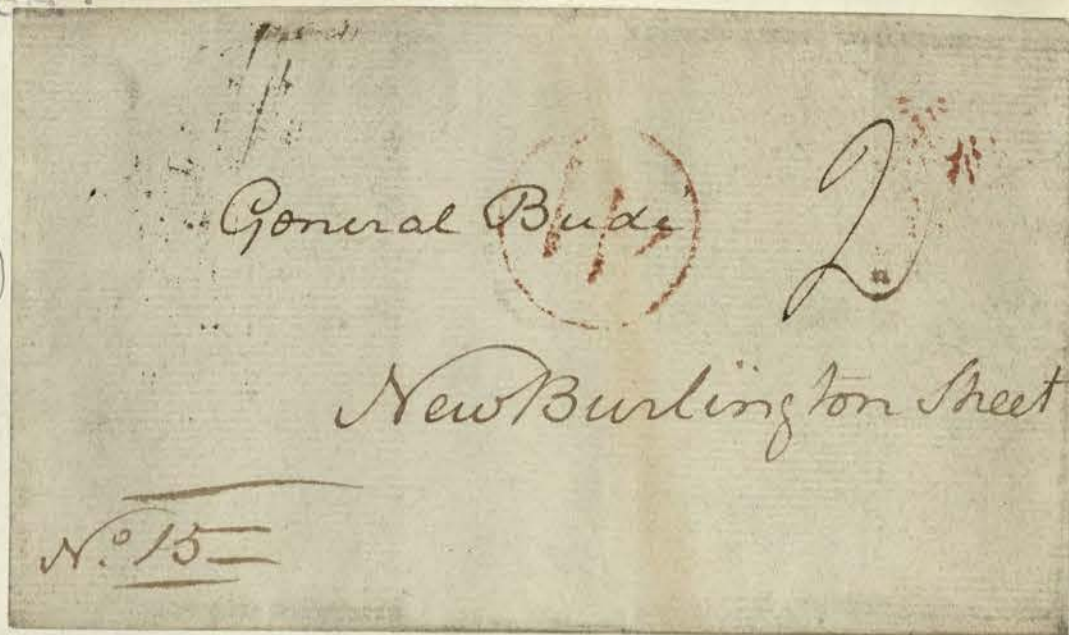

Sir,

At my return home I discovered a mistake I had made in the charge of 5 Guinees for m<sup>rs</sup> Longo - lease to you, which w<sup>o</sup>d have been right had the lease & counterpart been one skin each, but being two skins each on account of the additional Duty &c. paid out of pocket - m<sup>rs</sup> Bullock & Arnold's charge uniformly is 7 Guinees - I have taken the liberty to trouble you with this - to request you will rectify my mistake - which I doubt not but you will readily do & for which purpose I will attend you any time you will be so obliging as to appoint - I am Sir
