Now, know ye, That, from the Date of these Presents, and so long as the said  
*Lieut. Genl. Jacob Bude* shall duly pay, or  
cause to be paid, the said Sum of *One pound Seventeen Shillings & Six pence*  
at the Times and Place aforesaid; and the Trustees or acting Members of the said  
Society, for the Time being, shall agree to accept the same; the Stock and Fund of  
the said Society shall be subject and liable to pay to the said *Lieut. Genl. Jacob Bude*  
*his* Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, all such *his* Damage and  
Loss which *he* the said *Lieut. Genl. Jacob Bude* shall suffer by Fire, not exceeding the Sum of  
*Fifteen Hundred*  
Pounds, according to the exact Tenor of their printed Proposals, dated November  
the First, 1794, and of Two Acts of Parliament, of the 22d and 37th of GEORGE  
the Third, for charging a Duty on Persons whose Property shall be insured  
against Loss by Fire. In Witness whereof, we (Three of the Trustees or  
acting Members for the said Society) have hereunto set our Hands and Seals, the  
15 Day of *May* 1800
