you, without loss of time -
payable on demand, or at
any other time, you will say.
I make the debt 48 £. If I am
not correct, pray rectify it - I am
sure you still blame me, for
what, I cannot help, I am
more, to be pitied, than blamed

I am sure, never was a family
so cruelly circumstanced, as
mine is: I am with respects
