Sir 22^d of July 1818

Your esteemed favor, was not
sent here, this day's post, when I
arrived, Tuesday, in consequence of a
letter received, from Mrs. Belton,
here, I shall endeavor, till something
turns up for me, having settled
my legal business so, that legal
forms alone prevent the Executors
paying me, which they will do in
all October, they must have, however
willing, they may be, what is termed
the sanction of the Court, as there
are children concerned in it, and

that cannot be had, till that time,
it is above, 1300 £ s, with the interest
and I have you 100. only, to consider
out of it, and 130 £, having avoided
taking any money esp. from any
debitor, or any other quarter.

I correspond with the Stuffed, I
am sure, there will be a vacancy soon
and I shall have it in addition
to the third ventures / never to be forgot,
that you have caused, to be made
in my favor, my friend is in it, on
the spot, never cease improving
Col^d Ellis, on my account; I have
been very poorly, since I intended
best upon you, Mrs. Pulson bids

of the manifold favors, I have receiv-
ed at your hands, we have I sup-
pose you, grateful hearts, I am
all ready, with resignation for a

my last shilling. I will not trou-

of course expensive, we are very
low indeed, I have had of you, 58 £
if you will enclose me, 20 £ more,
which can be no office to you, till
my 1st Nov^r, it will relieve us, from
the pressure of the moment, which
is very severe, I give you my honor
and I solemnly declare, I will
never intrude again, it will save
our credit, and cannot be worth a

thought to give, as to so little a time
for its return: be so good, when you
draw a draft, to make it, to some
of Beaver, which is necessary, or
Banbury, without a Stamp, they
