 Sir
 I have had the honor of
 receiving your Royal Highness's
 letter; and I assure your Royal
 Highness that I am very happy
 that your Royal Highness was

 we did me the honor of
 me. I will certainly
 wait upon your Royal Highness
 on Friday. I am afraid that
 I shall not be able to wait
 on Saturday as many persons

will see me in London; and
I must start to the north
two or three following days
of the receipt of them.

We could not hunt in
this part of the country till
yesterday when I went out
with the Duke. We had
not much sport; and the
riding was very dangerous.
But not so much so as on
the preceding Monday.

It is now raining; and I think
the usual course of
hunting will be recommended.
