To the Queen's Council. Sept. 20. 1811.

It may explain the King's state yesterday sufficiently well to say that His Majesty passed more than four hours after supper under restraint - His manner appeared excited soon after the Physicians left him in the morning - and as the day advanced His Language became coarse and loud, and His manner turbulent - He being all his dinner, however, with good appetite -

His Majesty slept some hours last night - but became intractable at three o'clock in the morning. His conversation with the Physicians ~~and~~ their interview has been a ~~whispering~~ rather wild and most extravagant notion - detailed all in perfect good humour - and tho' interrupted from time to time by ^{the} surprise, & perplexity at the arrangements which His Majesty was explaining, yet resumed easily, and continued until it was impossible to

discover any error either nature or
truth.
