Memorandum respecting the Medical Attendance.

The Ordinary Physicians, viz Sir Henry Hallford, Doctors Baillie & Heberden relieve each other so as to attend Two whole days each in the Week from Monday morning to Sunday morning.

Mr Dundas comes on Sunday morning & returns on the Monday towards the Afternoon for which it is presumed that he charges 1½ day. —

The two Doctors Willis are generally here together, and the Attendance of either one or the other is constant. —

Dr John Willis occasionally goes into Lincolnshire for 10 days or a fortnight more or less, and Dr R. Willis occasionally goes to London for a few days. — It does not seem that <sup>Periods of</sup> the absence of both would amount to more than four whole months in the Year. —

The Attendance of the three Ordinary Physicians therefore
