

Weymouth July 13. 1801.

The King authorizes His Secretary at War to acquaint the
 Supreme Commissioners for the Affairs of the Royal Military
 College, that He approves of their Recommendation of
 Lieutenant Colonel de Marchant as Lieutenant Governor
 and Superintendent General of the Royal Military College,
 that General Dury be appointed Commandant of the
 Senior Department, and that the Officers, ~~and~~ Professors,
 and Masters now employed at ^{Wey} Weycombe be considered
 as transferred for the present to the Establishment of
 the Royal College, and be accordingly authorized to act
 in their several Capacities, with the Pay, and Salaries, ^{affixed}
 to their respective Names. And further that Charles
 Greenwood Esq^r be appointed Treasurer, and Lieutenant
 Colonel M^c Kenzie Assistant Barrack Master General
~~and~~ Secretary for the Affairs of the Royal Military
 College.
