It being our intention that the
Sacht you command should be at
Calais by the 1st of October next,
accompanied by the Comet Steam
Vessel, for the purpose of conveying
Their Royal Highnesses The Duke
and Duchess of Clarence to this
Country; You are hereby required
and directed to proceed with the
two Vessels to Calais, so as to be
there by the 1st of October, as before
mentioned; and receiving on board
Their Royal Highnesses, with their Suite,
&c., convey them to such place in
England

England as His Royal Highness may
desire, and after landing them,
you are to return to Deptford, and
see the Yacht safely laid up there;
replacing the Comet under the
direction of the Navy Board; and
ordering the Galliope, when you
have returned to her, the Officers
and Men sent from her to the
Royal Sovereign, to return to
Portsmouth to follow her former
orders.
