the Scheldt, the Maese, or the
Flackee by Helvoet, or take any
other entrance circumstances
may induce you with the advice
of the Pilots to prefer, with a
view to removing Her Majesty
with the least possible inconve-
-ience to the Rhine Steam
Boat, which will probably
be waiting for Her at Dort.

And so soon as Her Majesty's
shall have left the Yacht
and informed you she no
longer requires your attendance,
you are to return with the
Yacht to Deptford for further
Orders. —


Two
