We have received your letter of the 10th instant, in explanation of Joseph Voy, a Pilot, being employed to take the Royal Sovereign Yacht from Deptford to Gravesend on the 9th of October last, a Trinity House Pilot being on board the Yacht at the time; and we acquaint you, for your future guidance, that two Pilots should not have been employed for the performance of this Service; and that the payment of one only will hereafter be allowed on such occasions.
