I am commanded by my  
 Lords Commissioners of the  
 Admiralty to acquaint you  
 that in consequence of  
 your recommendation for  
 arming the Yachts with  
 one 12 Pounder  
 Howitzer, instead of two  
 3 Pounder Brass Guns, they  
 have directed the Board  
 of Ordnance to issue one  
 such Howitzer to His  
 Majesty's Yacht under your  
 command for her present  
 voyage, and that on your  
 report of it, after her return,  
 will depend whether they  
 shall be generally adopted
