and Walls.

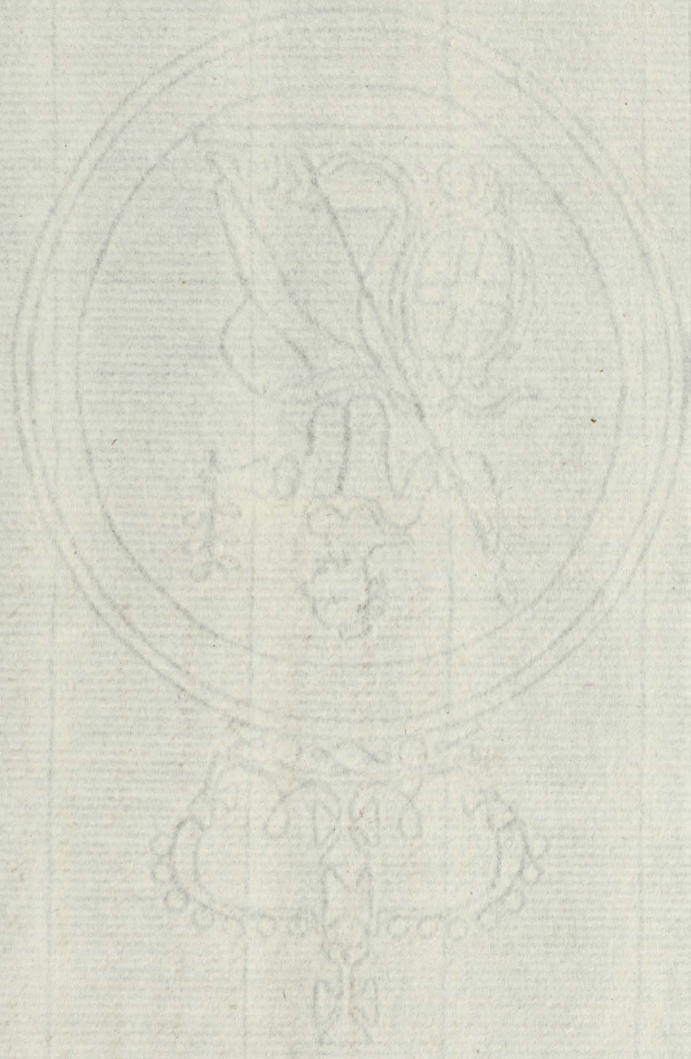
