 Letters, chased, pin'd and water gilt  
 encompassing and affixing do. (forming  
 descriptive Inscription) the edges  
 grooved and gilt to shew a double  
 Shield, the back of Shield curved  
 and gilt in white gold, two strong  
 cased and stamp'd red leather straps  
 and fixing do. with brass heads  
 screws and sockets - - - 64-16-0

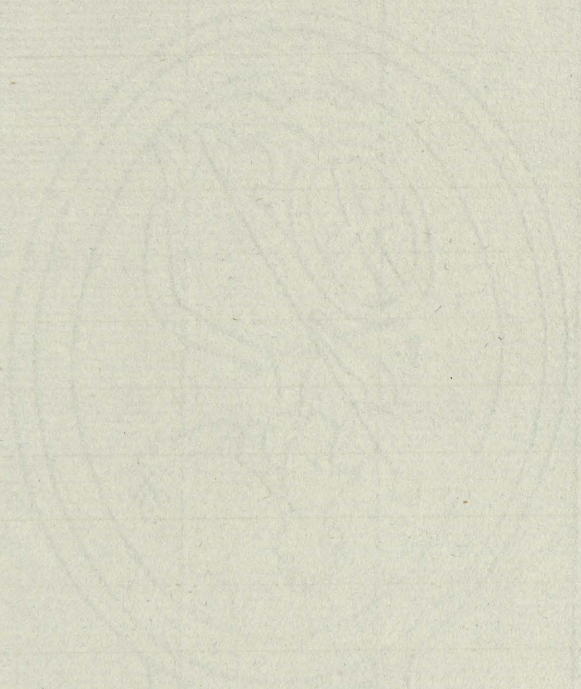
