If there be now issued from the Privy Purse an extra sum of
£650, and the future quarterly payments be ^{therein} increased to
£1250 (instead of £600), it will liquidate the present debt within
three years, and at the same ^{time} prevent an accumulation of fresh
debt, provided the Expences should not exceed the above average.

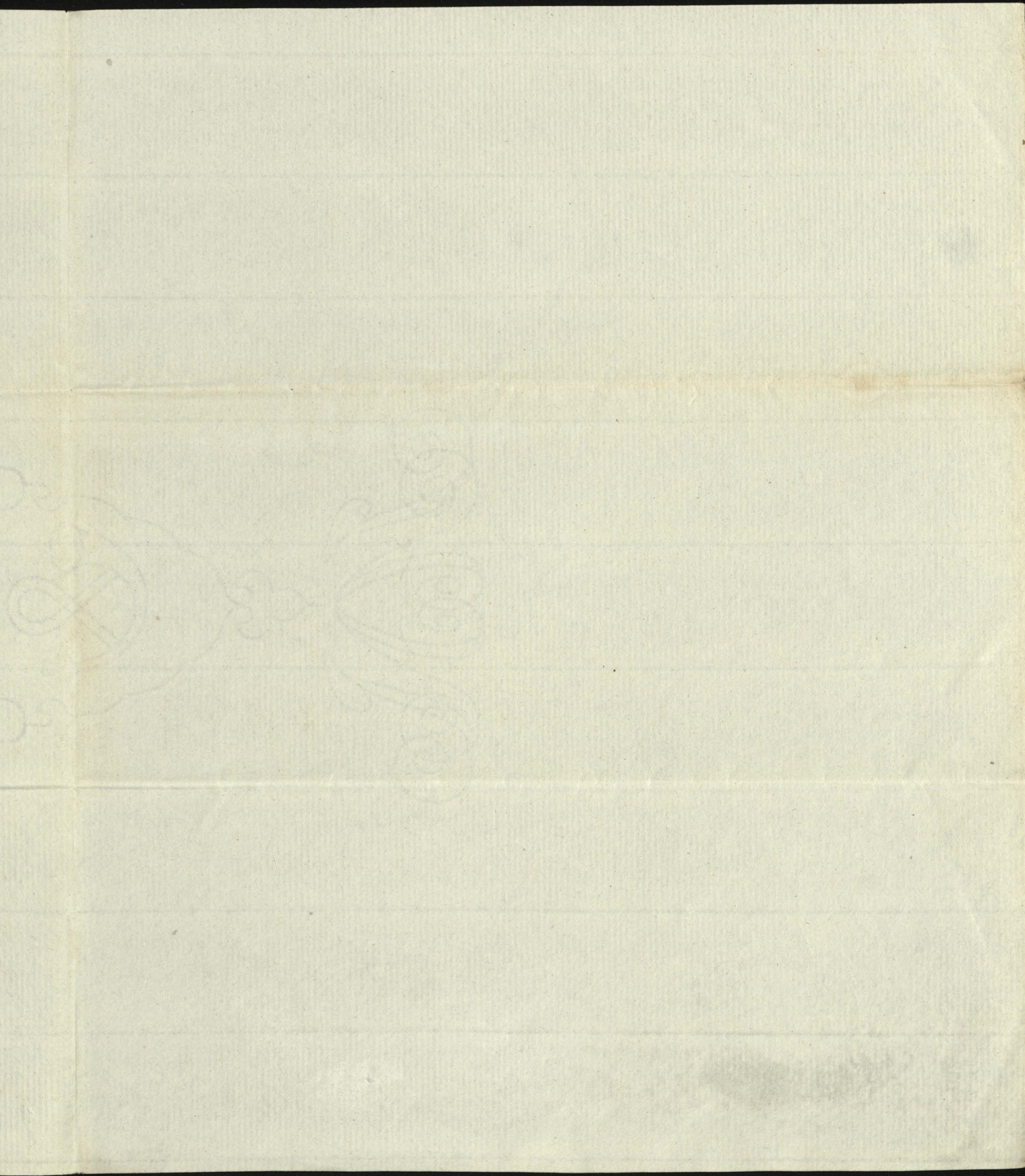
