I perfectly recollect the late Majesty making a Distinction between Her different Sets of Teevels, & being very careful to heef the great det of Brilliants, includ. ing the Stomacher and Nosegay, the Set of dearls ver, distinct from the rest. - The Queen expressed great anxiety whenever Stones belonging to those Sets, had been unscrewed, I worn with other Tewels, to have them immediately replaced; Twhen I proposed to have some of Feer late hajesty 's Dearls strong to the great Dearl Nechlace, which was rather short, Then hazesty objected to it; making use on these Occasions of the term "they are not my own". I believe this term applied to all those Tewels which are described on the outside of the different cases, in which they are contained, as having been found on The Lucen's arrival in England. - Her hajesty excepted the large Dearl Drop, in the center of the rechlace, telling me that The brought it from hecklenburg. The large Brilei ant Drops, denominated as the Gift of the Nabol, were considered by

Her late hajesty, as ther own. I am confirmed in this Belief, by the Recollection of one particular Licemotance. - at a time when The Luceu's Treasury was embanassed, The late h: Drice proposed selling one of these Stones, and The Majesty asked of Mi Bridge the value of them for that purpose, which Her eftreme Conscientionsness would not have suffered Feer to de, where The considered them as entirely Then own Inoperty. Besides the large Deare Dwp, I can speak positively only to a Brillians Chester Thing, as, according to The lake hazeste's own account of them, belonging to Shecklenburg. - Thave some Recollection that Her hazerty shothe of the large bulliant Cluster Buttons as belonging to hecklenberg, but went not swear to it, wer to the number. / signed Charlotte Beckedorff.
