deceased therein annexed was proved approved and registered Her said Majesty having whilst living and at the time of her death Goods & Chattels or any Credits in divers Counties or Jurisdictions by reason whereof the proving and registering the said Will and the granting & administration of all and singular the said Goods & Chattels and Credits and also the auditing allowing and final discharging the Amount thereof are well known to appertain only and wholly to Us and not to any inferior Judge and that administration of all and singular the said Goods & Chattels and Credits of Her said Majesty deceased and any way touching the said Will was granted to The Right Honorable Charles George Lord Arden and Herbert Taylor Esquire the **Executors** named in the said Will they having been already sworn well and faithfully to administer the same and to make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the said Goods & Chattels and any Credits and to exhibit the same into the Registry of our said Court on or before the last day of July next ensuing and also to render a just and true Amount thereof.
