Decreasde hereinabove annexed was proved approved and registered as her said Majestys having nothing living and at the time of her death Goods Chattels or any  
Credits in divers Provinces or Territories by reason whereof the proving and registering the said Will and the granting of administration of all and singular her said  
Goods Chattels and Credits and also the audit and allowing and final distribution thereof according to the will of her late Majestys to appertain only and in title to us and not to  
any inferior Judge and the administration of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of her said Majestys deceased and am now returning the Will was granted  
to The Right Honorable Charles George Lord Arden and Herbert Taylor Esquire the Executors named in the said will they  
having been already sworn well and faithfully to administer the same and to make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the said Goods Chattels and any  
Credits and to exhibit the same unto the Registry of our said Court on or before the last day of July next ensuing and also to render a just and true Account thereof.
