Gravenstein June 1th 1807

My dearest brother

Being commission'd by the Princess to lay her most humble thanks at your feet for your very kind reception of her I take the liberty to join my most grateful acknowledgements for this & many other marks of your unremittd goodness. The 15 of this month I leave this place, as I must see the Prince Royal before I leave these regions, your orders will be punctually obey'd the moment I get them. If I am to Embark I will be at Gluckstadt as the Ships can not come to Husum, & that I should not be too much fatigued I stop at Glucksborg to take leave of my Sons & of the Dukes & Duchep of Bevern who have really been all kindness to them. at Schwia the Prince of Orange & the other Highness will take me up a couple of days before I come to Kiel where I must stay a few days, if then I receive no summons I shall go to Altona to see the poor Duchep of Mecklenburg, & wait there your final decision, if I am to follow the torrent if the occasion should present it self that we are oblig'd to submit to the Tyrant I ever am my dearest brother
