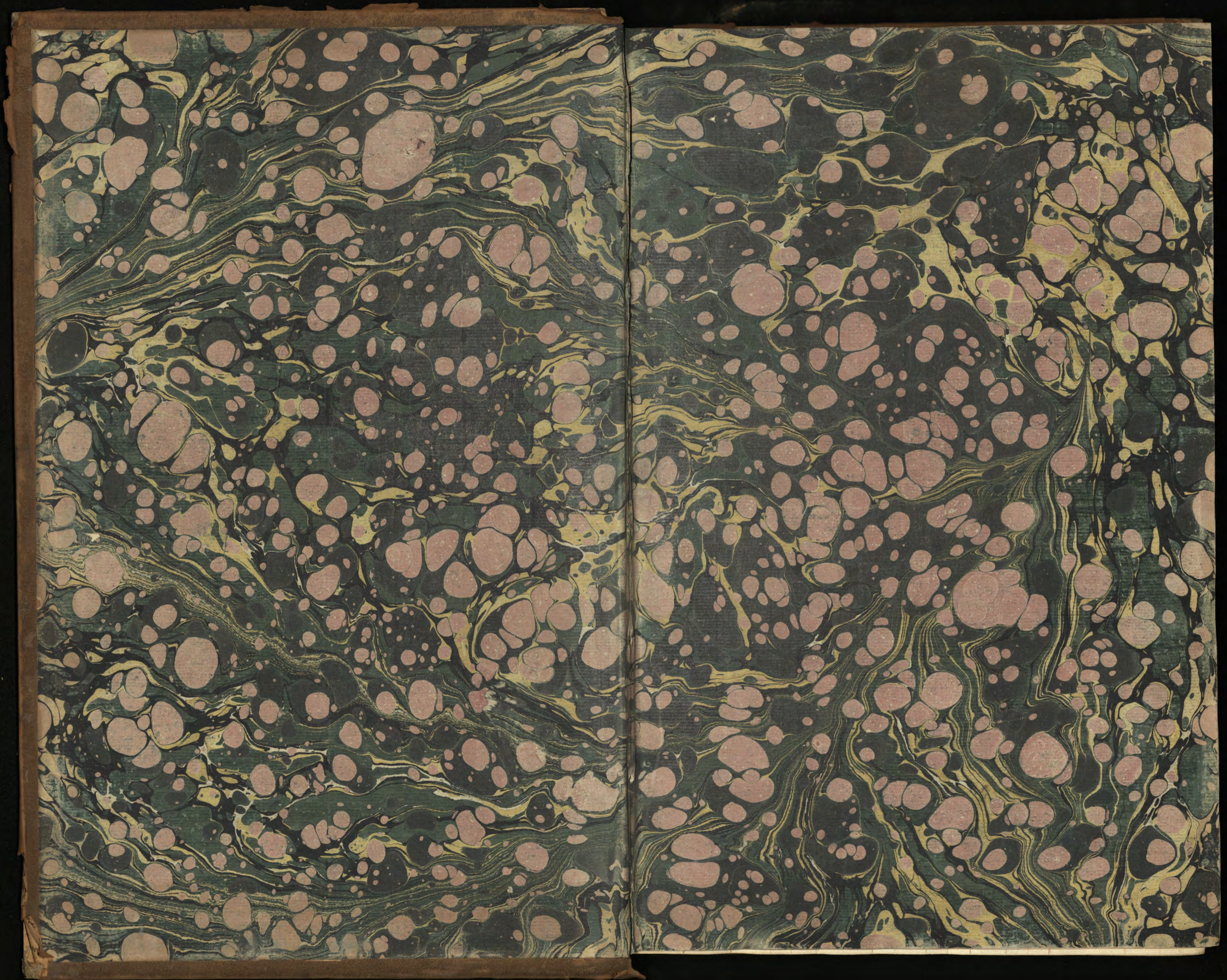

Whereas it is Our desire and intention to appropriate out of Our Income payable at His Majesty's Exchequer from the Fifth day of January next last past the Annual Sum of Thirty Thousand Pounds, as a Fund for the liquidation and discharge of all such Debts and Claims against us now existing as Our Trusty and Wellbeloved William Adam Esquire Our Chancellor and Keeper of Our Great Seal, General Samuel Aulse Our Treasurer and Receiver General, Thomas Syrrhill Esquire Our Lord Warden of Our Mannors in the Counties of Cornwall & Devon, John M'Mahan Esquire Our Auditor of Our Duchy of Cornwall and Secretary and Keeper of Our Privy Seal, and Thomas Coult of Piccadilly in the City of Westminster Esquire, or as Our Chancellor, Treasurer, Lord Warden and Auditor for the time being and the said Thomas Coult, or any three or more of them, shall in their Judgment deem to be fair debts and Claims, and fitting to be liquidated and discharged: Our will and Pleasure therefore is that you pay or cause to be paid unto the said William Adam, Samuel Aulse, Thomas Syrrhill and John M'Mahan, or to Our Chancellor, Treasurer, Lord Warden and Auditor for the time being, and to the said Thomas Coult, or to any three or more of them, the beforementioned sum of Thirty Thousand Pounds yearly, by four quarterly payments of Seven Thousand five Hundred Pounds in each quarter of the year, immediately as the money receivable for our use at His Majesty's Exchequer shall come into your hands, such payments to continue to be made as aforesaid until such time as the whole of the debts and Claims as aforesaid shall be liquidated and discharged. And for so doing this, together with due acquittances for the same, shall be to you a sufficient Warrant Given at Carlton House this Ninth day of March One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eight in the Forty Eighth year of the Reign of Our Royal Father the King.

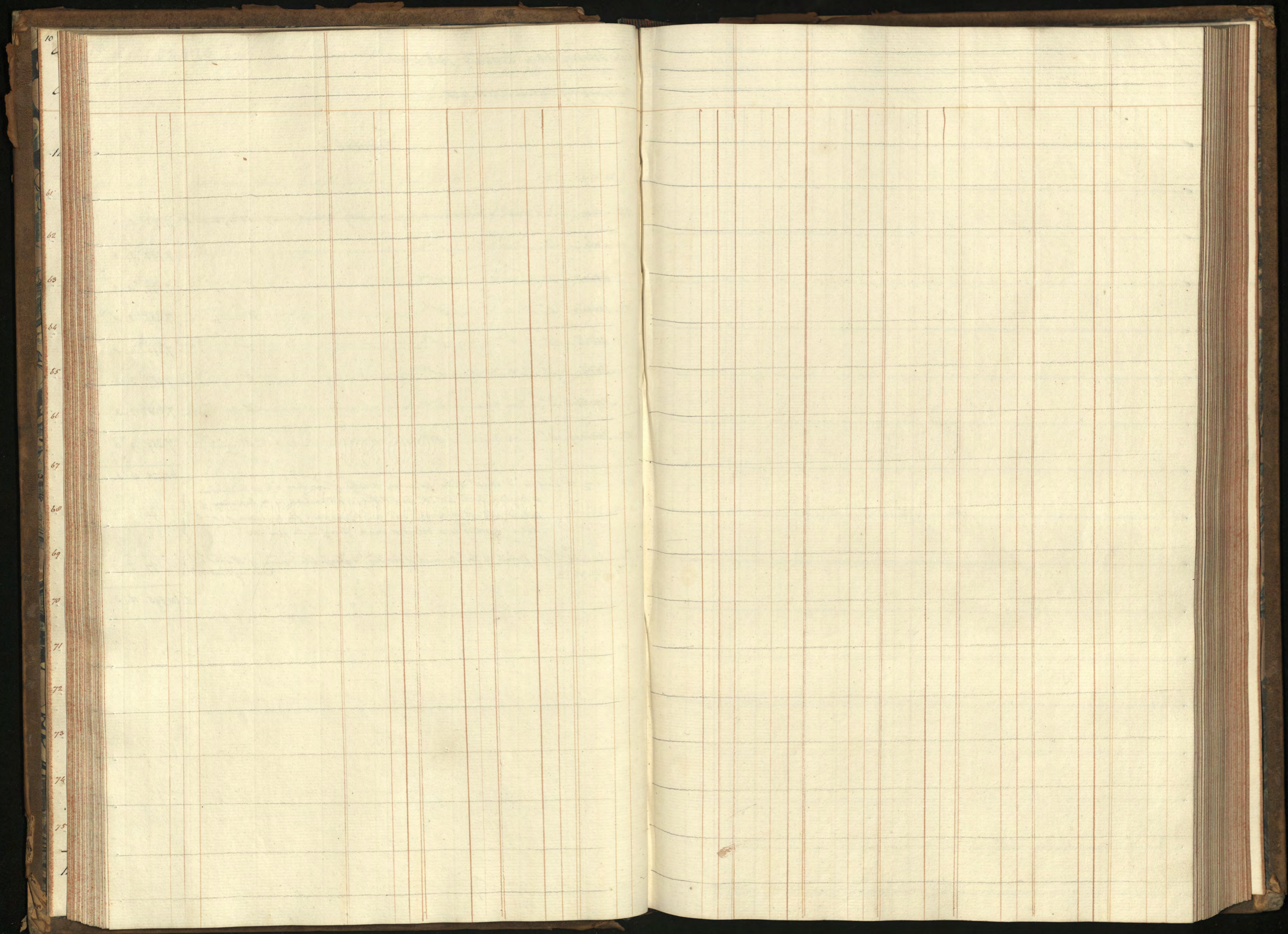
