Dear Mr. Morshead,

When Mr. G. H. Chettle wrote, towards the end of November last, pointing out that certain items in the MS. given by the Marquis the Queen to the Windsor Castle Library (of which typewrites were made here in 1922) related to the period of Charles II, I promised to look up any record of the passage of the MS. here and to write to her. G. H. Palmer, my predecessor, the then Keeper of the Library, about the matter.

The results were embodied
in my reply to Mr. Chettle, of
which I now beg to forward
a copy.

with our Charles I. inventories:
613—1902; 1753—1907, has gone,

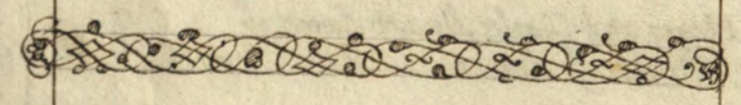

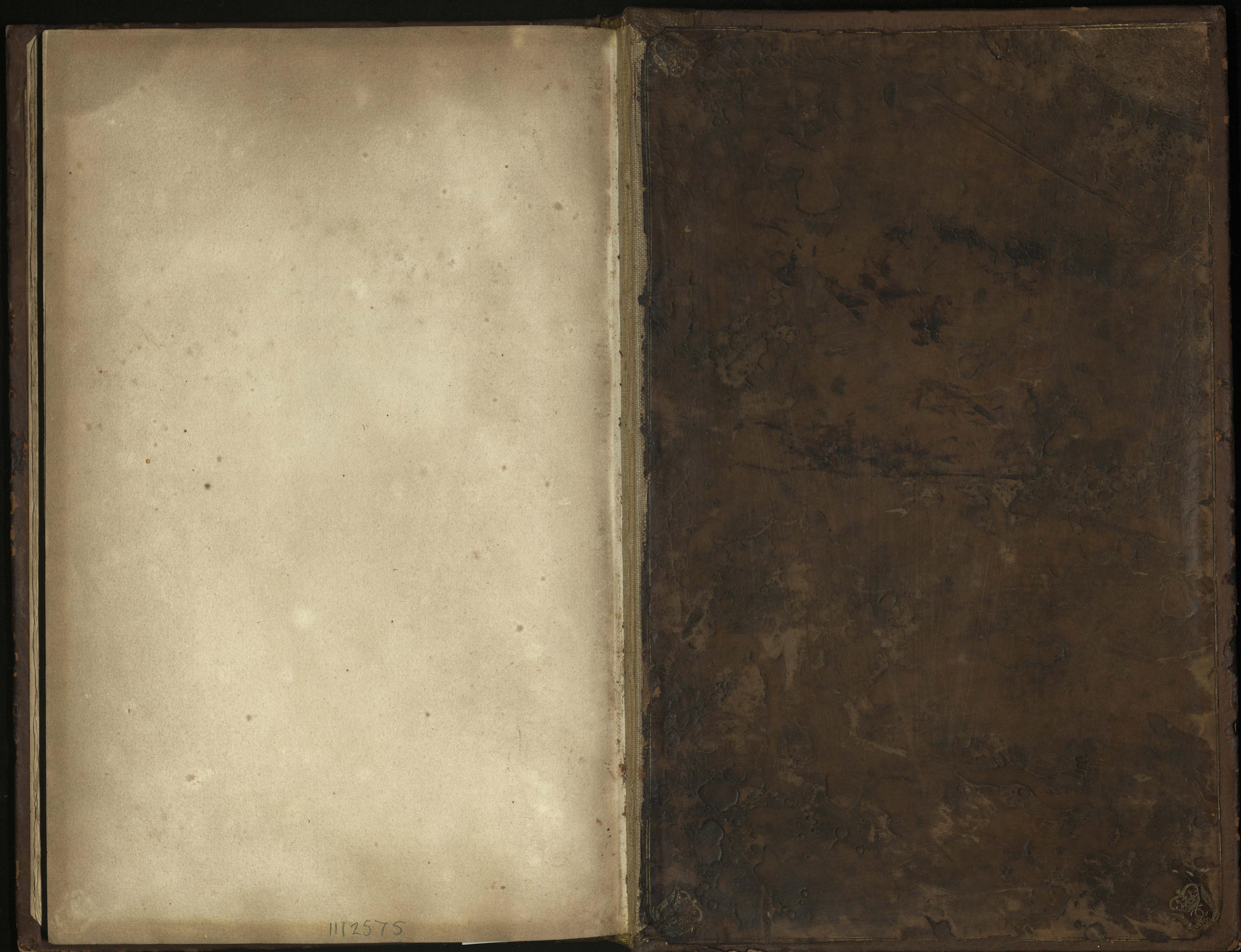
