

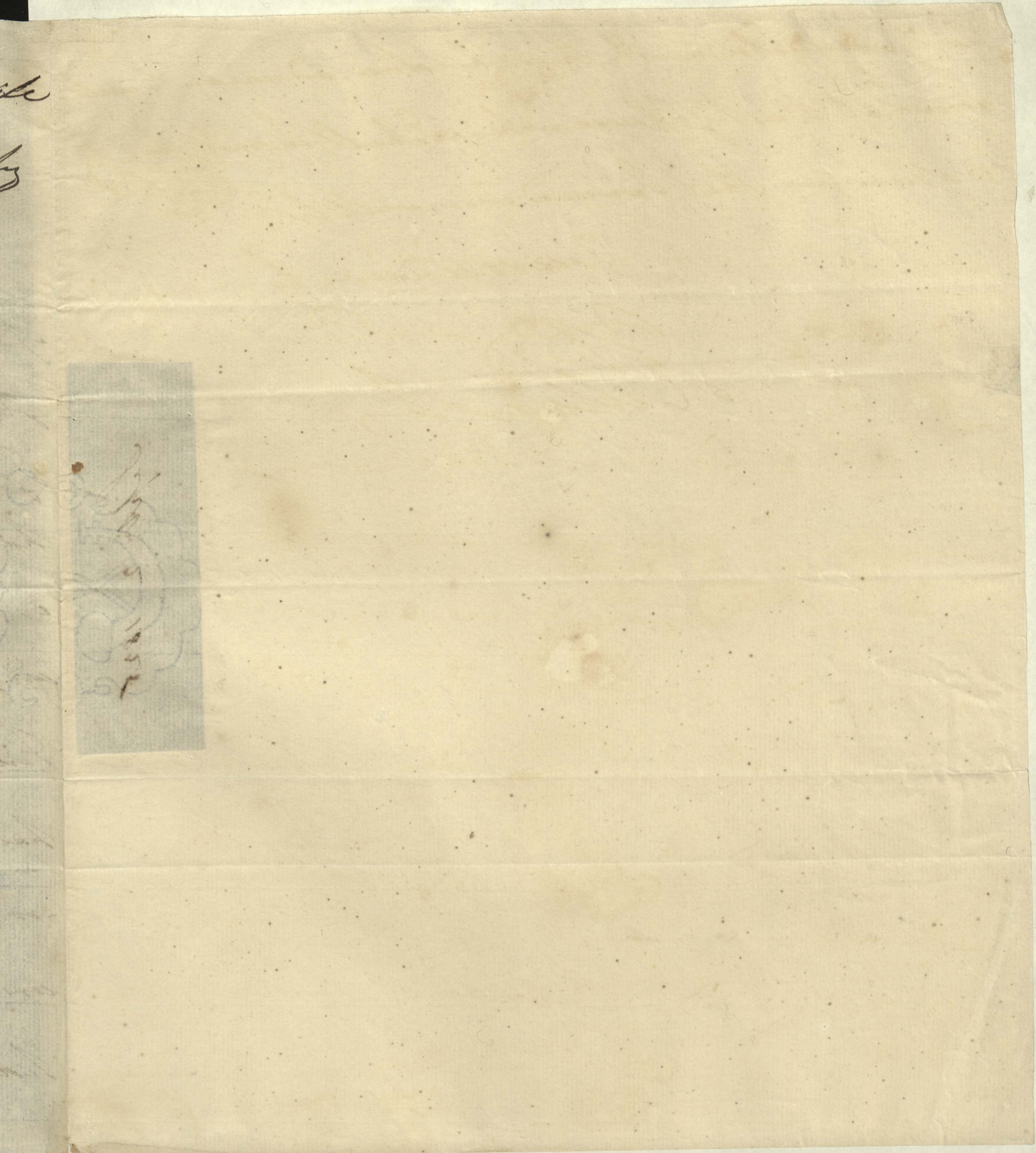
Alton,
