Dear Brother,

Of all the difficult tasks
that have fallen to my lot none has given me
so much real uneasiness as to determine
as a father and as the real friend of
my son whether I ought to journal: I have
thought it over again and again and the only
consideration against his going being his ex-
treme youth and having reason to flatter

myself that he will on his landing be placed
in the family of Mr John Pomeroy which will
obviate many of the difficulties of his going
I shall be with him at Portsmouth on Mon-
day next between four and five.

The distress of Mrs Jordan is not to be de-
scribed however like what she is one of the best
and one of the ablest of women she sees the
prosperity of his going.
