I came to town with the

-tended I am obliged to bring the Deutchess
whenever they shall be building over the
kitchen & carried into effect will render

I must therefore request you will have the
kindness to lay this letter before His
Majesty and receive it as a matter involving
the real convenience and interest of the
State & so, are concerned. I say no more on
this point at present because I shall hope
shortly to see you and then explain by word
of mouth more fully the fact than I can by
letter.
