That you Deliver and pay of such his Ma^{ty} Treasure as remains in your Charge unto Thomas Onslow Esq^r his Ma^{ty} Out of the Exchequer of Windsor Forrest or to his Assignes the Sum of Two Hundred pounds without Account to be paid over to y^e Persons here named and in the proportions set against their Names in y^e Bill of their Services as Keepers of the said Forrest within the Parish of Balywick of Surrey, and in lieu of all Wages, Salaries, and other Allowances for One year from Mid^l 1714. to Mid^l 1715. From which time they are to be paid the same Allowances by the said Thomas Onslow Out of the said Sum of 200^l made payable to him by his Ma^{ty} Lett^r under the Great Privy Seal, for and in respect of the said Office of Ranger, & y^e Charges of executing the same.
