May 1835 in the Fifth Year of Our Reign.

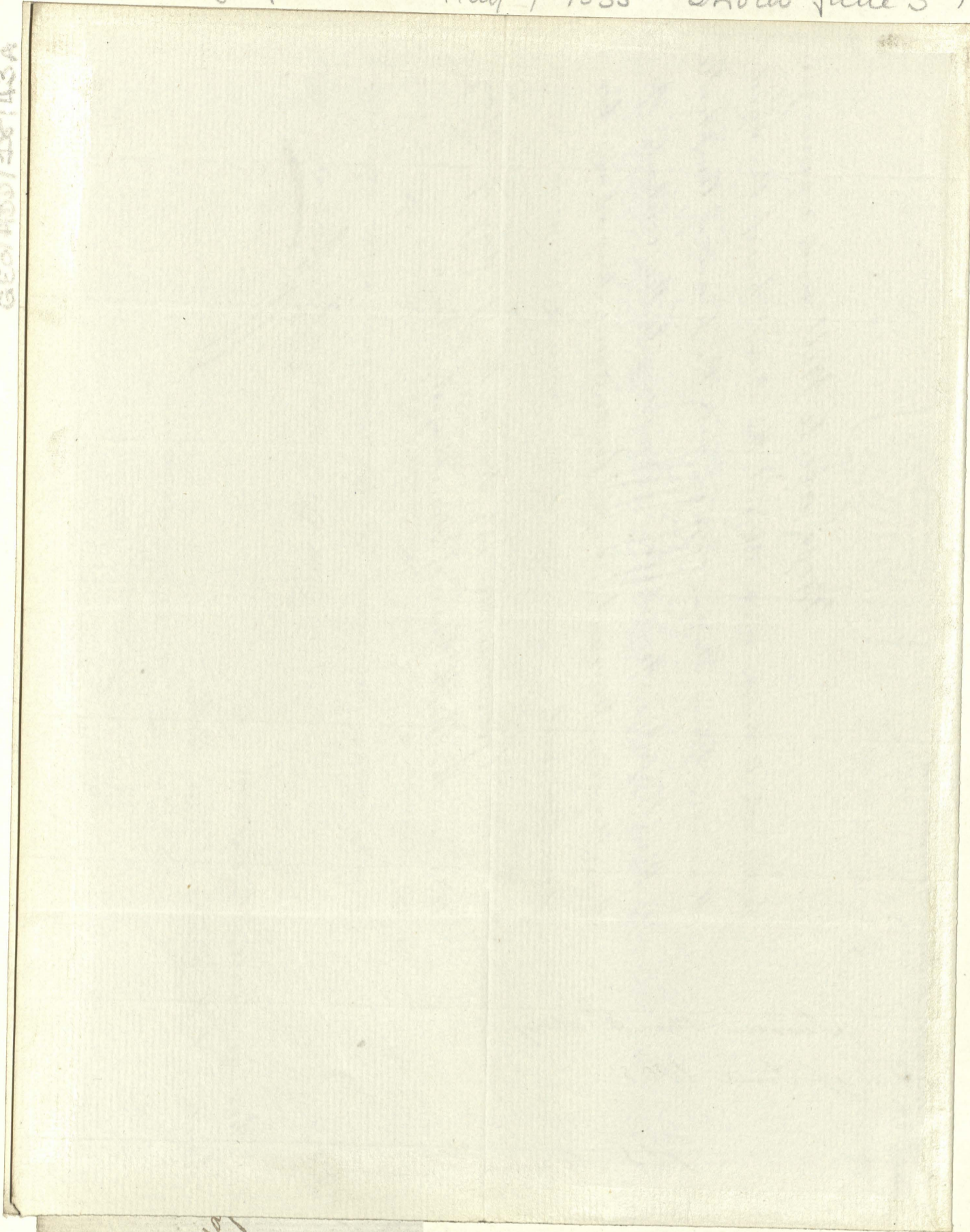
