As my Lord Townshend sends your Highness by this Messenger the King's patent for your Creations, I thought it proper to enclose the Key of the Box in this letter.

Your Highness will find an alteration in your patent from the Title I had the honour to send your H. at first. instead of Marquis of the Isle of Wight, it is now of the Isle of Ely. — Lord Viscount Windsor, who has the Title of Lord Mounjoy of the Isle of Wight, laid claim to a Title of that Island, w^{ch} tho' wrong found. d. yet it was thought better to leave out a Title w^{ch} had the least Dispute, & put in another, w^{ch} being proper for the Royal Family, was not at all litigated.
