to remark but that he feels the reasons are conclusive why
the Opening cannot be made in the Middle of the Music
Room, and Approves of the Arch to be put in the
Porch on a Bracket as was intended over the Chimney
but sufficiently high that the Stairs: ched may remain
in its present place. The Chimney in this case need not
be altered. The door into the old Corporation from the
Withdrawing to it must be now executed as well as
a passage at the back of that side of the Room from
whence the Communication will come to Mr. Egerton's
Room.
