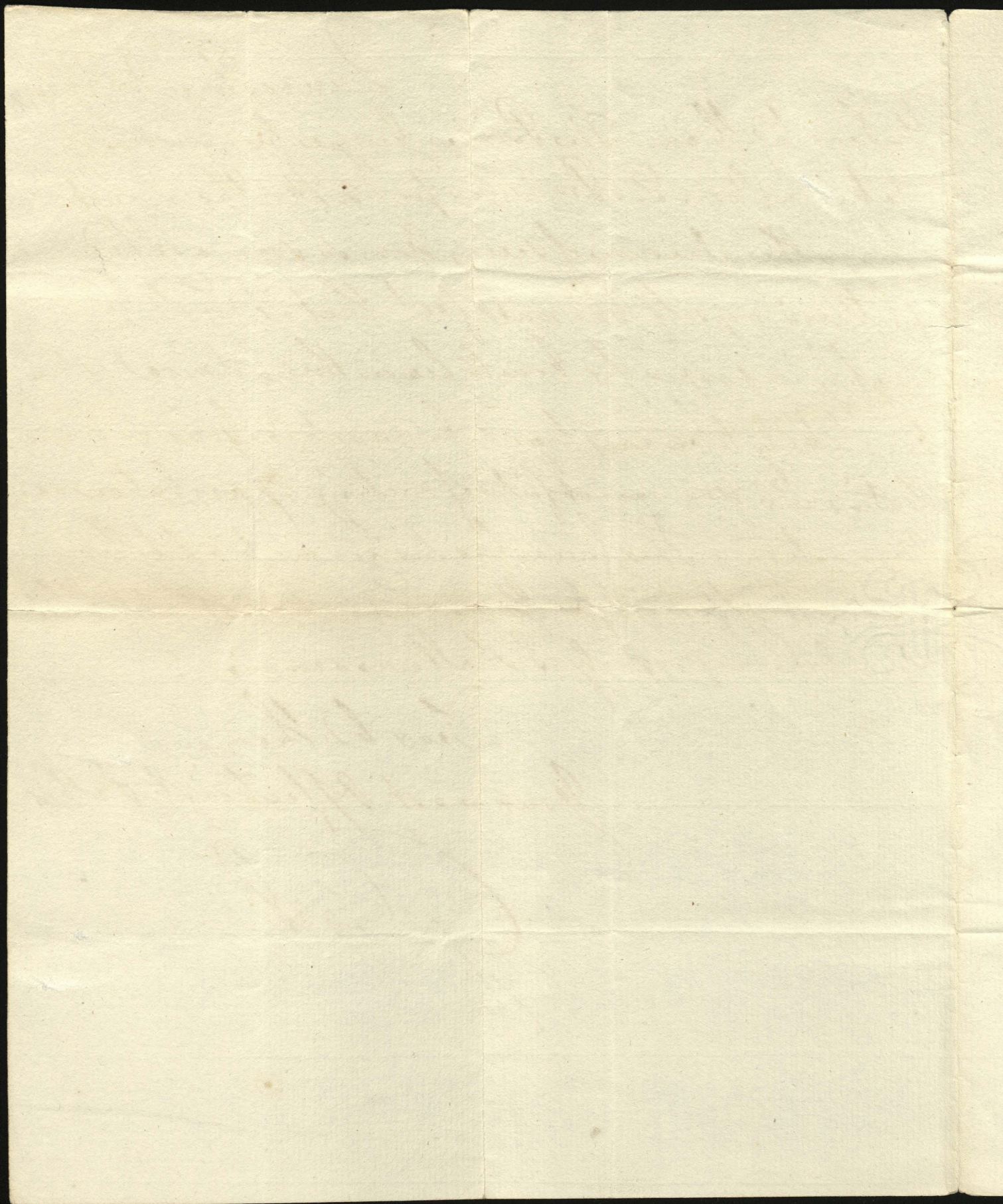
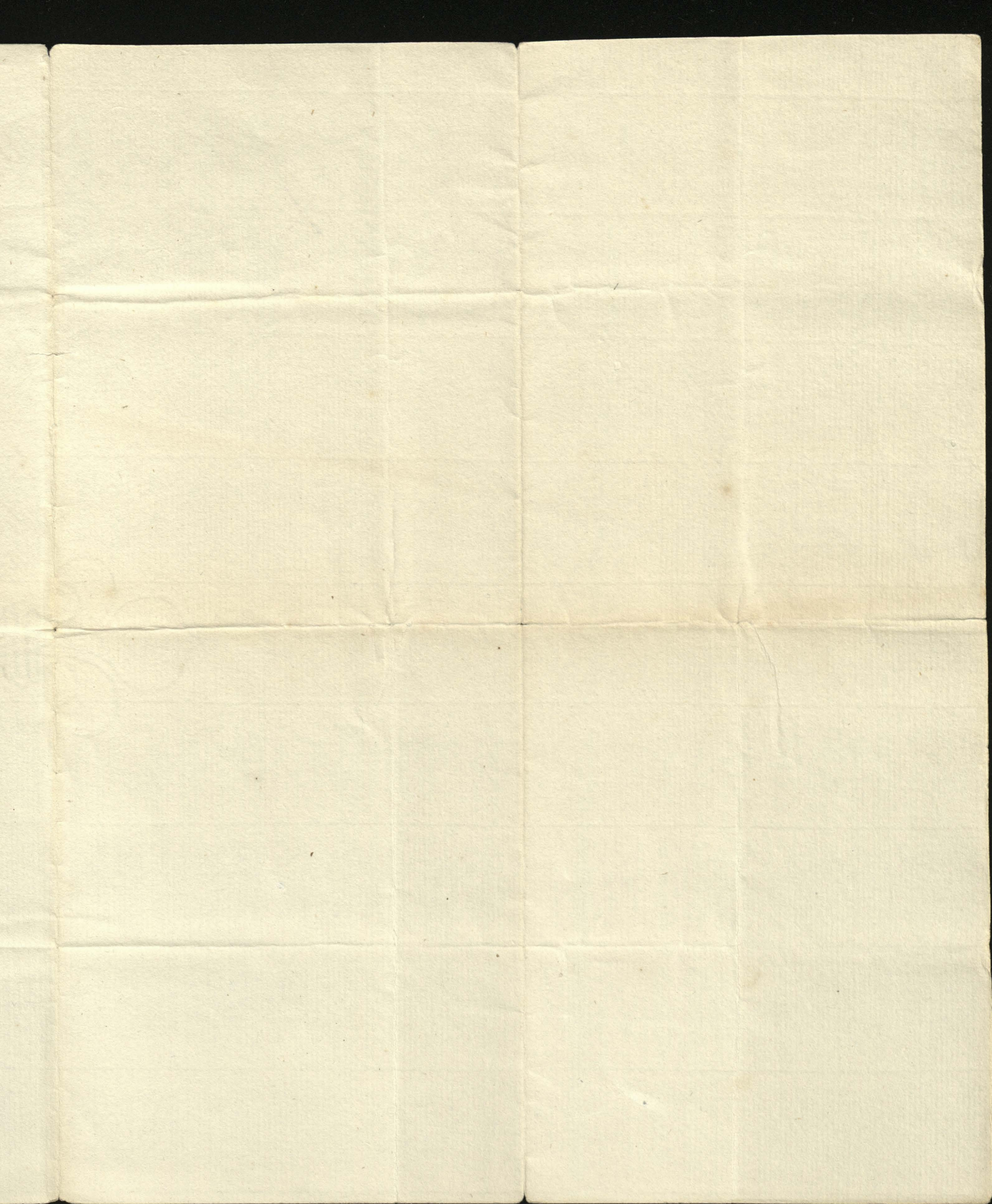


Queens House Nov. 29. 1779. <sup>(5)</sup>

Dear William, The Prince George being ordered to  
take in Stores and Provisions for six Months; I must  
forego the pleasure of seeing you so soon as I had  
flattered myself; you must feel that it would be  
highly improper for you to leave the Admiral when  
he is likely to be employed, be exact in your various  
Duties and you cannot fail of meeting approbation on  
your return. The Queen has desired me to add Her  
warmest Affection for you, and believes that whilst
