- 24 For Sending Two Men to Carlton House to move some Furniture " 5
- Paid Two Chairmen for bringing away a Libano Table and a Pier Table " 3
- July 26 - For Prime Cost expence of making a Model of a Large Candelabrum with three figures of Boys Supporting a Sazza " 4. 4
- Mar 3 - For a very elegant Writing Stand made of Red Saunders wood inlaid with black ebony and gilt Mouldings round the Troughs for the Pens ornamented with 3 Bronze Vases Copied from the Antique for Ink Wafers & Sponge highly finished @ 20 Guineas " 21. -
