Lord Rockingham this day came  
& complain'd to me as if he was  
awar'd of having wrong stated my  
opinion on the Stamp Act; I told him  
I had on Friday given him  
permission to say I prefer'd  
repealing to enforcing the  
Stamp Act; but that Modification  
I had ever thought both more  
consistent with the honour  
of this Country, & all the  
Americans could with any  
degree of Justice hope for.
