

Memoirs from Oct. 25. 1760.

The P. of Wales was riding at a little after eight o'clock ~~over~~ New bridge and the Via Milestone when a Messenger stopped Mr. Foxton and told him an accident had happened to the King, on communicating it to the Prince. He returned to New order'd his Attendants to be silent and pretended his Horse was lame; the Messenger produced a paper signed Schroder with a pencil the name of one of the King's pages. about Nine a letter notifying the King's death came from Prince's Amelia about ten Mr. Pitt came to <sup>acquaint</sup> ~~notify~~ the Prince with it and to know whether the Privy Council should be summoned the Young King order'd it to assemble at St. James's but afterwards <sup>sent it to the</sup> ~~order'd it to~~ at Carlton House as he had no servants in town and did not chuse to appear abroad a period too much in the Streets.
