till past 12 o'clk. Lord Rockingham immediately
went to the D. of Richmond's, calling upon Mr
Conway in his way - & hopes his Majesty will
receive the Copy of the Message fresh drawn with
the Alteration early in the Morning.

The Alteration being more agreeable to his Majesty
to their Royal Highnesses the Dukes of York &
Gloucester was most readily adopted, by all who knew
of it.
