His Majesty has directed
The Earl Waldegrave, to acquaint
The Princess of Wales, that The
Prince of Wales being now
advanced to the age of eighteen
years; His Majesty, out of His
tender regard, and affection,
for Him, had thought it proper;
that His Royal Highness should
be put upon a different Foot
from what He had hitherto
been; that The Prince might
appear, according to His High
Rank, Dignity, and Age.

That, for that purpose, It
was His Majesty's Intention
to make His Royal Highness
an Allowance of 40,000 [£] Ann;
And to direct, that The Apartment
of the late Prince of Wales at
Kensington, and another at
St. James's, should be fitted up

for

for His Residence; Where His
Royal Highness would be
attended, and accommodated,
in a manner becoming Him.

That His Majesty has
under His Consideration, the
forming a proper Establishment
for His Royal Highness; Which
The King will direct, should be
communicated to Him, before
It is finally concluded.

It is His Majesty's Intention
That Prince Edward should
accompany His Brother, The
Prince of Wales.
