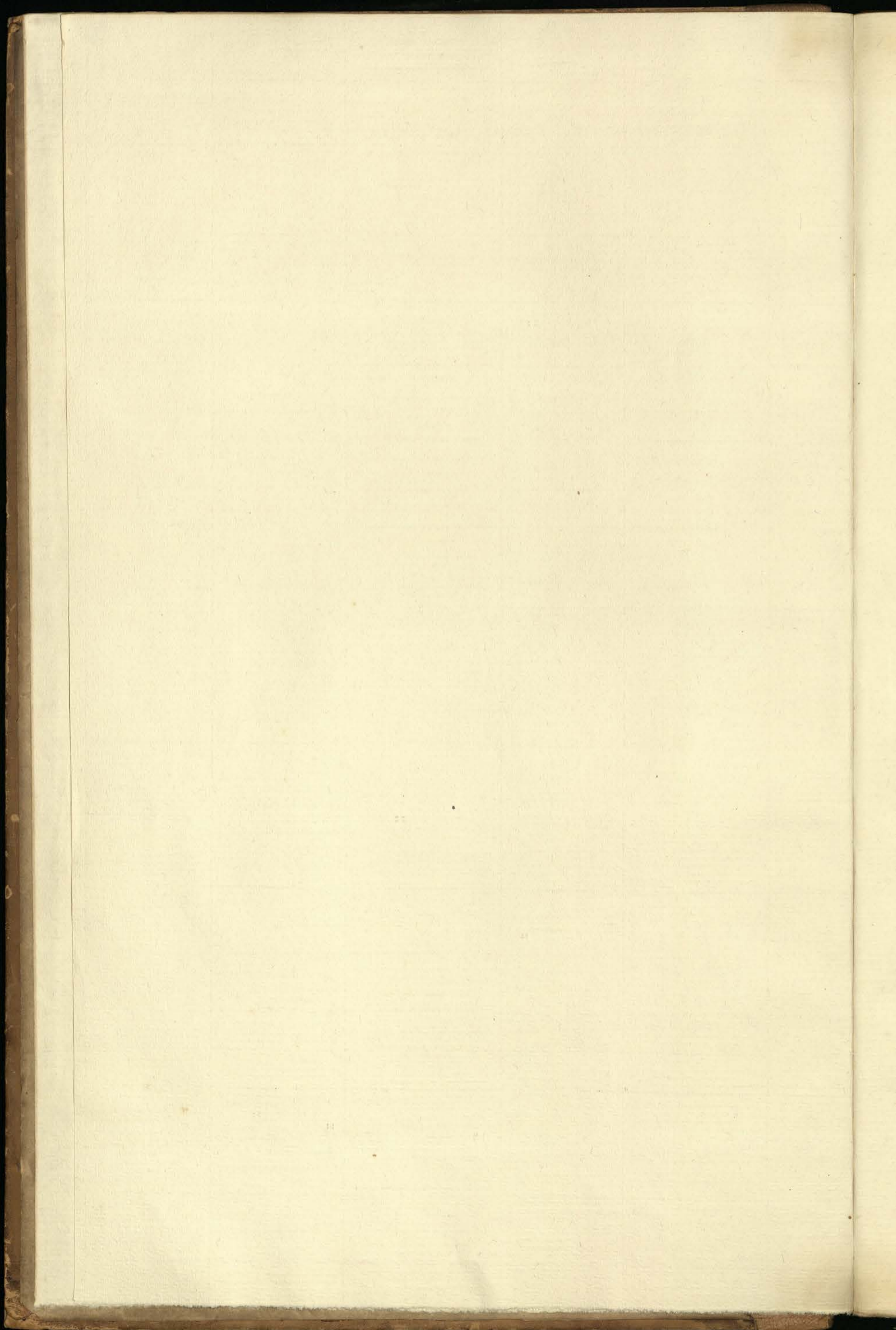

 the same in the Accounts of Our said Treasurer and Receiver
 General a sufficient Warrant until Our further Pleasure therein
 be duly made known Given at St. James the 20th day of February
 1617 in the Fifty seventh year of the Reign of Our Dearest Lord
 and Husband.
