Lord Hertford has every thing
prepared in case of the
Prince of Wales's death to
submit to his Majesty's pleasure
supposing that the directions
given by the late Prince
of Wales died will probably
in his Majesty's judgment be
the properest procedure to
follow; the orders were issued
by the privy Council in most
of the instances upon that occasion
& probably will be pursued by
the King's direction in this instance

if such an Court should take
place, but Lord Hertford will
be privately prepared to receive
and obey all necessary instructions
& commands that the most
perfect respect may be shown
agreatly to his Majesty's
pleasure
