Dear Brother,

When my arrival in town this
morning I found your letter here which I answer imme-
diately by assuring you that both the father and son con-
sider themselves invited and meant to pay you a visit.
As for my being down on the 25th it is out of my power,
because my little boy tho' not absolutely ill yet has a
complaint for which he has been for some time under
Warren's care and the Doctor is kind enough hindered to get
off going into the country till he has seen the effect of

a new course of medicine and has appointed the 2^d of
Apr. the next day of consultation: therefore I am
the 2^d I cannot leave home: on the 1st of Apr. Jordan has
sailed for his benefit and I should wish to beat the
-mond that night: therefore after the second I am
for a week at your command.

If you wish that and his son to be with you before
I go down with me word: if not we shall all there
come in second of Apr.
